

Announcement of the Ukrainian Pancreatic Club's recommendations

Recommendations of the Ukrainian Pancreatic Club for diagnostics and treatment of exocrine pancreatic insufficiency and relief of abdominal pain in chronic pancreatitis are planned to be published in the supplement of the third issue of our journal for the current year.

Of course, a lot of foreign recommendations have been published on these issues. However, in Ukraine, as in any other country, there are certain features associated with organizational issues, etiology and pathogenesis of certain pancreatic diseases, as well as with diagnostic and therapeutic opportunities. In drawing up these guidelines, the authors not only relied on the international statements, but also took into consideration the peculiarities of our country.

We consider publication of these recommendations necessary for the practitioners. We hope that they will help improve the quality of medical care upon pancreatic pathology. In order to reflect the various points of view in the recommendations, physicians, gastroenterologists, a surgeon, a nutritionist participated in their making-up.
